Goals and objectives support the organizations Mission or Purpose. Objectives are intended or desired outcomes, while Goals are measures of accomplishment.

Objective:

Promote understanding, knowledge and support for aeromodeling thru KCRC sponsored educational and charitable events.

Goals:

- Participate in one or more charitable aeromodeling events yearly.
- Provide training in aeromodeling to one or more school classes, Boy Scout Troops, or youth organizations yearly.
- Document charitable and educational events in KCRC's web site.

Objective:

Promote the safe enjoyment of aeromodeling for club members and the public at KCRC sponsored meetings, and flying events.

Goals:

- Host two or more AMA sanctioned contests yearly.
- In addition to any special events, host four (4) "Club Days" annually.
- Host a monthly club meeting with program for members and visitors.

Objective:

Promote the continued financial strength of KCRC.

Goals:

- Host a yearly Swap and Shop to earn a profit for the club.
- Keep any excess financial assets in interest bearing instruments or accounts.
- Operate yearly on a break-even or better financial basis.
- Safeguard and account for all club property on a yearly basis to the Board.

Objective:

Encourage member participation at club meetings and events and promote the value of membership in KCRC.

Goals:

- Award door prizes at each "Club Day" and business meeting.
- Present three (3) or more special recognition awards yearly at the Annual Appreciation dinner.
- Present awards to deserving participants at club sponsored contests.
